From November 1 through the end of February, the Air District will issue a *Winter Spare the Air Alert* when fine particle pollution concentrations are expected to reach unhealthy levels. During the *Winter Spare the Air Alerts*, it is *illegal* to use any wood-burning devices such as fireplaces, woodstoves, or pellet stove in the Bay Area.

How can the *San Bruno Chamber Group Health Plan* Save you money?

The San Bruno Chamber has exciting news about a new group medical health plan now available exclusively for chamber members that will help you lower your health care costs.

The results have shown that the *San Bruno Chamber Health Plan* will:

this restriction will be subject to a \$400 fine, which will increase with any subsequent violations.

Residents whose only source of heat is provided by wood burning, or who experience a break or interruption in gas or electric service are exempt from the *Winter Spare the Air Alert* wood-burning restriction (Regulation 6, Rule 3).

Eliminating residential wood burning during a Winter Spare the Air Alert can reduce particulate pollution by 35 tons each day as The San Francisco Bay Area is home to approximately 1.4 million fireplaces and woodstoves.

The **COMMUTER PRE-TAX FRINGE BENEFIT** for public transit riders and vanpoolers increased considerably when the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act stimulus bill was passed in February 2009. Up to \$230 per month per employee may now be set aside, *tax-free*, for mass transit and vanpool expenses incurred while traveling to and from the workplace.

To encourage employers to offer this cost saving plan to Peninsula commuters, the Alliance is promoting the Commuter Benefit Employer Incentive Program. Cash awards of up to \$1,000* may be earned to help offset start-up fees and to promote a new pre-tax commuter benefit program. To qualify, employers in San Mateo County may choose from three options: (1) an employee pre-tax plan; (2) partial or full transit subsidy up to \$230 a month per employee; or (3) a combination of both options.
